## Community meeting with Common Ground Trails consultants

at the Porongurup Hall  
Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> November 2021



Common Ground consultants David Willcox and Megan Watson met with residents of the Porongurup and surrounding communities for the purpose to discuss the following:

- determine level of demand [or lack of demand] for new trails,
- identify types of trails to be developed;
- identify trail locations; and
- list what is required to maintain existing trails.

During the same time period, an online survey was carried by Common Ground to provide an opportunity to comment on many of the Park's locations for trail opportunities. Results from the online survey and consultations will be provided to the Project Reference Groups representatives (**PRG**) at an early December meeting.
