

TWIN CREEKS NATIVE EARTHWORMS



AN EARTHWORM FROM THE NATIVE AUSTRALIAN FAMILY OF MEGASCOLEX CAN BE IDENTIFIED BY THE FACT THAT THE ANTERIOR BORDER OF IT'S CLITELLUM USUALLY LIES IN SEGMENT 13 OR 14. IF LESS THAN 18 SEGMENTS CAN BE COUNTED BETWEEN THE FRONT END OF THE WORM AND IT'S CLITELLUM AND THE LATTER ENDS IN THE VACINITY OF SEGMENT 18 IT IS PROBABLY A MEGASCOLICID NATIVE AUSTRALIAN EARTHWORM
